



Mid-Isle Soccer Club Parent Code of Conduct

COMMITMENT

Mid-Isle Soccer Club (MIS) is committed to providing a safe and positive soccer experience for your child. This agreement is intended to explain the expectations for parents of MIS players. The purpose of this Code of Conduct is to make everyone aware that there is an expectation of appropriate behaviour, at all times. This agreement is an acknowledgement of mutual understanding, to help ensure that MIS players, coaches, volunteers, staff and parents all enjoy a positive soccer experience.

Actions that violate this Code of Conduct may result in the removal or suspension of the Parent or Player.

SAFETY

Safety is our number one priority. It is important that we work together to provide a safe environment for all participants. Safety responsibilities and expectations of parents or guardians of a MIS player(s):

- No smoking, drinking, vaping at any of the fields or in the stands
- Ensure your player is healthy and hydrated for practices and games
- Foul language, harassment, bullying or abuse to anyone involved in the sport will not be tolerated.
including the opposing team
- No offensive or gang affiliated clothing or displays at the field

COMMUNICATION

- I understand that my son/daughter is expected to attend all training sessions, games and activities associated with their team (including during injury – to observe/listen; but excluding illness) and if my son/daughter will be absent that the coach/team official must be notified in advance
- I understand that I must respect the coaching and administrative staff, my peers (other parents/families), referees, and the volunteers of MIS. Negative comments or behavior towards any of these groups or individuals will not be tolerated
- I understand that there will be zero tolerance for any negative behavior towards game officials.
- I understand that any coaching from the sidelines during training sessions and games will not be tolerated and I may be asked to leave
- I understand that any feedback I may have, must be communicated to one of the team officials (Head Coach, Assistant Coach or Manager) first, and then direct concerns to Risk Management Officer (riskmgmt@midislesoccer.ca) Such contact should be away from other players/parents and in a location away from training or game facilities

POSTITIVE SPORT PARENT AGREEMENT

I agree to committing to be a supportive Sport Parent by:

- Encouraging my child's passion for soccer by keeping my expectations reasonable
- Teaching my child that winning isn't everything by modelling good sportsmanship
- Supporting my child regardless of sport performance and motivation
- Letting my child be coached and mentored by another adult by not coaching from the stands
- Supporting and respecting the decisions of officials
- Providing positive support and encouragement to my child's teammates
