



INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

The health and safety of all members and associates is a high priority for Mid-Isle Soccer. Here on Vancouver Island the weather can change drastically and without notice. Please take the time to read the information provided.

AIR QUALITY:

Air Quality Health Index must be 6 or lower 1 hour prior to the start of the match.

People with pre-existing health conditions, respiratory infections such as COVID-19, older adults, pregnant women and children are more likely to experience health effects from smoke exposure. Please make the best decision for your family.

HEAT WARNINGS:

If temperatures.

- rise above 38 - matches will be abandoned
- are between 32 and 38 – matches must have at least one, 2-minute water break in each half
- 32 and under – proceed as normal.
